
PowerStream - Historical Development

- In 2001 Hydro Vaughan Distribution Inc. and Markham Hydro
 Distribution Inc. jointly purchase the electricity distribution assets of
 Richmond Hill Hydro Inc. from the Town of Richmond Hill and
 continued to operate the utility on a stand alone basis.
- In June 2004 Hydro Vaughan Distribution Inc., Markham Hydro Distribution Inc. and Richmond Hill Hydro Inc. merge to create the third largest municipally-owned electricity distribution company in Ontario. The new entity is named PowerStream Inc.
- In November 2005 PowerStream Inc. purchases the electricity distribution assets of Aurora Hydro Connections Ltd. from the Town of Aurora.
- In January 2009, PowerStream Inc. and Barrie Hydro Distribution Inc. merge to create the second largest municipally-owned electricity distribution company in Ontario, serving more than 330,000 customers in 11 Simcoe County and York Region communities. The company, jointly owned by Barrie, Markham and Vaughan, retains the corporate name of PowerStream Inc.

Achieving Synergies Through Mergers

- In the past PowerStream has achieved merger savings results have been in the range of 10 - 15% of combined OM&A.
- Through economies of scale and achieving synergy savings, the PowerStream – Barrie Hydro merger realized operating savings of approximately \$5.5 million annually, and approximately \$1.0 million in annual capital savings.
- PowerStream has been able to achieve the merger savings with no forced layoffs.

Financial Summary

- PowerStream has approximately \$1.08 in total assets.
- PowerStream maintains a capital structure consistent with the OEB's deemed capital structure of 60/40 (debt-toequity), with the ability to leverage up to 65% debt should PowerStream require additional cash;
- Currently, PowerStream's EDFIN gebt is rated "A" by Standard and Poors. The rating reflects S&P's assessment of the risk profile of the least creditworthy participant. In addition, PowerStream is rated "A" by Dominion Bond Rating Service.
- Since 2005 PowerStream (including the former Barrie Hydro) have paid dividends totaling over \$100 million to its Shareholders.
- The opportunity for Collus Power to recapitalize its debt-toequity could provide Collus Power with the ability to free up capital.


Our Community Support



Customer-focused Operations

- 24 by 7 System Control Room monitoring has led to significant improvements in outage response times and reliability -- Reliability Index now in excess of 99.99%
- Interface built from Smart Meter AMI to Outage Management
 System to allow for rapid, "smart" outage response for customers
- First utility in North America to pilot test FDIR smart grid application for automated instantaneous fault finding, isolation, and power restoration.
- Completed construction of new Park Place Municipal Sub Station (approximately \$3 million investment) to service continued growth and expansion in south Barrie
- Continued significant capital investments to support growth, expansion, refurbishment, and maintenance of the distribution system in Barrie






